Tuition & Scholarships

Simple, transparent, and ministry-accessible pricing

UIBC seeks to make ministry training affordable by offering differentiated tuition for diaspora students and Africa-based students, along with flexible payment options and limited scholarship assistance where available.

Payment Options

- Full Payment: Students may pay the total program fee at the beginning of the program.
- Monthly Payment Plan: Students may pay month by month according to the approved fee schedule.
- Bridge Course: Intended for students progressing from Diploma level or for transfer students meeting entry requirements.

Scholarships & Financial Support

- A limited number of scholarships or tuition assistance opportunities may be available to qualified students.
- Support may include partial scholarships, donor-supported tuition assistance, special payment arrangements, or ministry-based sponsorship where available.
- Students seeking support may be asked to provide an application for admission, a short explanation of financial need, a pastoral or ministry recommendation, and any additional supporting information requested by admissions.

Scholarship Availability

- Scholarship opportunities are limited and may not cover the full cost of study.
- Because available funding depends on sponsorship and institutional resources, students are encouraged to apply early and inquire about support during the admissions process.
